The 2018 National Watershed and Stormwater Conference marks the third year for the Center for Watershed Protection's annual event. This conference will help practitioners, regulators, water and sewer authorities and stormwater managers overcome common hurdles — from staff shortages and a lack of financial support to addressing multiple pollutant sources in mixed land use watersheds. address cross cutting issues and emerging trends in watershed management and implementation. The conference will include national sessions via internet, along with local hubs to encourage more in-depth discussion, and networking.

All attendees will have the opportunity to watch the nationally broadcast portions of the webcast focused on the major conference topics.
